Federal Way screening locations and shelter are open in the winter only. No shelter services for women in Renton; shelter for women in Kent is from Nov. 1-March 31. Shelters generally rotate among groups of churches in Kent, Renton and Federal Way. Majority of facilities do not provide laundry or showers. Programs do not serve individuals convicted of sex-offenses, methamphetamine production, arsons, and some violent crimes within the previous three months. Accepts other offenders on a case-by-case basis.

OPEN – Congregations for the Homeless – Eastside Men's Shelter

INTAKE: Nightly at 8:30pm.

Provides seasonal shelter for up to 50 men, 18+, in the fall and winter. Provides dinner and breakfast as well as sleeping mats and blankets. No daytime storage services are provided. Clients are admitted until the shelter closes at 7:30am. Closes April 30, 2017.

OPEN – King County Winter Response Shelter – King County Administration Building

King County Admin buildings at 420 & 500 4th Ave, Seattle, 98104 [Map](#)

INTAKE: Nightly, 7pm. Shelter: nightly, 7pm-6am.

Previously operated as a seasonal shelter, is now open year round, but has the capacity to add beds when needed. No meal, hygiene or daytime storage services are provided. Service animals and pets are allowed. Shelter is operated by staff from the Salvation Army - William Booth Center. Shelter open to men, 18+. Line up just south of the courthouse and Jefferson Street, next to the large garage door on Jefferson. Access to the shelter takes place through the loading dock on Jefferson St., just up from 4th Avenue. **A single line is formed for access to both shelter sites.**

Hours: CALL TO GET ON WAITING LIST - Shelter operates daily, 7:30pm-6:30am. Lights at 9:30pm.

Operates a winter shelter for men and women in rotating Lake City churches. The shelter will house approximately 30 guests per night. Trained staff members and volunteers will be operating the shelter each night. Meals will be provided by the host church. Guests at the shelter must vacate the neighborhood during the day, but limited bus tickets will be available.
